## Long Lake Park Campground Rules

You are entering an area that may have natural hazards. The hazards could be of many different kinds. Be aware of your surroundings. If you see something that may concern you, please inform the office immediately.

We reserve the right to refuse entrance to anyone on our properties and facilities, or add / change a rule at any time for the good of the business and / or the safety of our guests.

Respect your fellow campers, their campsite and their property. DO NOT cross through a campers yard to take a "shortcut". Stay on the roads while walking / riding while in the park.

If you have a Golf Cart or borrow a Golf Cart during your stay, please obey the 5 MPH speed limit while in the park. Only licensed drivers can operate Golf Carts. Golf Carts parked by Midnight, no exceptions.

Quiet hours are from 11:00 PM to 8:00 AM.

Children 13 and under must be on their campsite by 9:00 PM. All children under the age of 18 must be on their campsite by 11:00 PM.

ALL visitors MUST be registered at the office **BEFORE** they go to your campsite. If guests are found on your campsite without a mirror tag, there will be an additional \$5.00 charge per guest that is not registered. If the guest is found a second time without being registered, they will be asked to leave, without re-entry until the following day. You will still need to pay for your guests even if they are asked to leave.

Guests are NOT permitted to enter Long Lake Park Campground after 9:00 PM.  
Day Guests cost \$7.00 per guest and leave the Park by 11:00 PM.  
Overnight Guests cost \$12.00 per guest and leave the Park by 1:00 PM the next day.

ALL late arrival guests can be registered in advance at the office by YOU. If you are unable to register your guest before the office closes, please use the after hours registration box on the front porch of the Store/Office. Cash and check payments available at the drop box, but CC payment need to be made first thing in the morning when the Store/Office opens.

Unregistered guests found on the property WILL BE TOWED AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE. If the tow truck is called and arrives, you will be responsible for paying the tow truck bill. Tow Truck services provided by Heffelfingers in Loudonville, call (419) 994-4788.

Your trash is to be taken to the Dumpsters outside the gate by you. We do not offer trash pickup service.

The Playground is made for children 12 years of age and younger. All children need to be accompanied by an adult at all times. No throwing stones or climbing up the slide. Only 1 child per swing. NO SMOKING or Glass containers in the Playground area. Do not leave trash behind.

Fishing rules are as follows: Crappie limit of 8 per day, must be at least 10". All Bass are on a Catch and Release limit. You DO NOT need a fishing license for our private Lake. All other fish caught have no limits. We enjoy seeing pictures of your catch at the office.

Pool rules are as follows: NO FOOD OR BEVERAGES at the Pool (except water bottles). You cannot be alone, there must always be 2 people at the Pool. Parent / Grandparent must be present for children under 12. NO PETS at the Pool. If you swim in the Lake, you are not permitted at the Pool on that day, NO EXCEPTIONS.

You must always have at least 1 person 21 or older on your campsite in order to stay the night. No one under the age of 21 is permitted to stay alone.

NO SMOKING in any common area of the Park, to include the Pavilion, Playground, Pool, Shower House, Laundry Room, Office, Store or Porch, and take your BUTTS with you!

Pet Rules are as follows: Pets welcome, but owners must be well trained! Walking your pet is only allowed between the hours of 8:00 AM and 7:00 PM. All pets must wear a collar that has their license on it. Pets are not permitted to be left alone, outside the camper at any time. When walking your pet, use a leash not longer than 6'. Pets not permitted in the Store, Office, Playground, Pool or Shower House. Children under the age of 6 cannot walk a pet alone. Aggressive breeds are not welcome in the Park.

Service Dogs are welcome!

Anyone creating a NUISANCE during their stay will be asked to leave the Park immediately.
